



Fringe Salon COVID-19 Policy

We are so excited to get back to work. We have missed you all greatly and will be doing our absolute best at maintaining a safe environment as we navigate through COVID-19 together. Please read this before your appointment so you know our policies and when you should reschedule your own appointments. Please be patient as we are trying to work with in the guidelines provided by the IDPH.

Please know coming in sick is not an option for clients or staff. We want to keep everyone healthy and safe so we have these policies to do just that.

Please reschedule your appointment if:

1. Anyone in your household has been sick, fever or other symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
2. If you are pending a COVID-19 test result.
3. If your health is at risk, please wait for your own safety.

* Coming in sick is not an option! If you fail to be honest about this and or come in with a fever we will refuse service and there may be a late cancel fee.

In Salon Policies:

1. You must use hand sanitizer or wash hands after sign in and temp check.
2. We will not have beverage service or magazines at this time. You may bring one with you but put mask back on between sips.
3. We will have limited seating in waiting area. Please feel free to enter, if the front is busy with check-ins please wait outside until we clear area, to help maintain distance.
4. Please be patient as we have to sanitize our area after each appointment.
5. You must wear a mask that goes around the ears and maintain 6ft from others in the salon at all times. If you have a doctors release it must be present. If you refuse to wear a mask, we will refuse service and you may have to pay for part of your appt.
6. We prefer you not bring people along for your appointment, unless they are receiving services as well.
7. Please refrain from touching retail shelving, the staff will get the products you need.
8. Nail and waxing services will be at the discretion of each stylist.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as this is our new normal and not how hair salon services will continue forever. As they change restrictions these policies may change.
